

ASI Standards Revision – 1st Consultation

ASI runs a global standards and certification program that covers the aluminium value chain from bauxite mining through to final products. **17 February 2026 marks the opening of the first round of consultation on the draft revised ASI Performance and Chain of Custody Standards.**

When is the consultation period?



The consultation period will run for 62 days, closing on 20 April 2026. Stakeholder feedback during the consultation plays a vital role in shaping the next generation of ASI Standards.

We encourage you to get involved and have your say.

What are some of the proposed changes?



Revisions include both structural and content changes.

For the Performance Standard, in addition to updated criteria, a new (optional) tier of leading practices have been introduced, and applicability/materiality has been reviewed throughout.

The Chain of Custody Standard (CoC) has been streamlined and stakeholders are invited to give input on three potential models to evolve the current CoC approach.
