Aluminium process scrap waste streams were identified and the site monitors the quantities of scrap sent to third party recycling on a regular basis. The site implemented a Continuous Improvement programme with the target to reduce the amounts of scrap generated. Management reviews were in place to ensure targets are regularly monitored.</p>
4.3b Aluminium Process Scrap (alloy separation)	Conformance	<p>Amcor released a pledge in January 2018 to develop all its packaging to be recyclable or reusable by 2025. This makes Amcor the first packaging company to make such a commitment.
