ENTITY OVERVIEW

Tianjin XinLizhong Alloy Group Co., Ltd. (the 'Entity') was established in 2019 and operates under the Tianjin XinLizhong Alloy Group at No. 58 Taimin Road, Western District, Tianjin Economic Development Zone, Tianjin, China. The facility comprises an administrative office covering 8,795 square metres (m²); Factory #2 covering 9,084 m²; Factory #4 functioning as a raw materials warehouse with an area of 8,655 m², and a finished goods section combined with Factory #3, occupying 3,885 m².

The Entity primarily serves the domestic automotive parts manufacturing sector, employing around 180 staff with an annual production capacity of 150,000 tonnes. It operates 15 furnace sets, including nine melting furnaces, five alloy furnaces, and one pilot furnace, along with six pouring machines and six ingot coding machines. Supporting infrastructure includes office buildings, employee dormitories, canteens, warehouses, parking lots, distribution boxes, air compressors, natural gas pipelines, and circulating water tanks.
