The FPIC Process

Overview

Step 1

Appoint a group that will represent the affected Indigenous People in the upcoming FPIC process

Step 2

Collect and document knowledge and information about the affected Indigenous community

Step 3

Gather information about the ASI Certified Entity and the other stakeholders who have interest in the land.



First contact with the ASI certified entity



Implementation and monitoring of the agreement, with Indigenous People included in the monitoring and implementation



Joint design of the FPIC process, timeframes, costs and establishment of a process agreement. The Entity should offer independent tech/legal support at their cost



Conduct an Indigenous-led Participatory Cumulative Impact Assessment (IPCIA)



Negotiate an agreement with the Entity using the information that was gathered in the IPCIA.

Receive information

Process and evaluate information

Make the decision



Finalise and formalise an agreement with the Entity if the community provides consent
