MEETING PRINCIPLES	ASI's acknowledged Indigenous Peoples and their connections to their traditional lands where ASI and its members operate. A reminder of the importance of ASI's Anti-Trust Compliance Policy and its application to all participants was also provided.
CHAIR	ASI Board Chair, Sasha Courville, took the Chair.
QUORUM	The Chair noted that a quorum of Members was present at the meeting and declared the meeting open.
CHAIR REPORT	The Chair shared reflections on ASI's key results, governance highlights and the development of ASI's current strategy. The Chair tabled the audited 2024 Directors' Report and Financial Statements, which had been circulated to Members in advance of the meeting. Members were invited to comment upon and ask questions on these during the panel session.

ELECTED DIRECTOR

Recently elected Director, Rene Klopper and continuing Director, Catherine Athenes were congratulated and the outgoing Director, Matthias Esdar, was thanked for his service. A welcome was extended to Anders Blom who has recently been appointed to the Board's People and Governance Committee.

STANDARDS COMMITTEE MEMBERS

The Committee is currently engaged in the nominations process to fill two vacancies in the Industrial Users membership class. The Committee extended its appreciation to the retiring members for their dedicated service and contributions. The Committee also acknowledged the ongoing valuable work carried out by the Standards Committee.

The contributions of Working Group participants and the Secretariat were also acknowledged.

CEO REPORT

The ASI CEO, Fiona Solomon, reflected on 10 years of ASI and the value ASI brings to individual members and the wider supply chain. Feedback from the annual Governance Survey was shared and methods to maximise membership benefit were presented. A demonstration of the new elementAL assurance platform was shown.

DIRECTORS PANEL

Attending Directors participated in a live panel discussion on ASI's Strategy and Members had an opportunity to ask questions of the Board and CEO. Topics discussed included: current challenges in the political landscape and the potential implications for sustainability leadership; the importance of prioritising real sustainability progress over reporting; and future strategic opportunities for ASI.

Q&A WITH SECRETARIAT

Members had the opportunity to ask questions of the ASI Secretariat on program activities and general matters. Topics discussed included: structural changes currently being explored in the Standards revision process; the potential for ASI claims related to product carbon footprint; how membership fee increases will support the delivery of ASI's strategy and member programs; and key focus areas for the Certification program.

There being no further business, the meeting was declared closed.
