ENTITY OVERVIEW

Guangdong Hongjin New Material Group Co., Ltd. (the 'Entity') was established in August 1996 and operates six production subsidiaries, including Foshan Nanhai Chuangli Non-Ferrous Metal Products Co., Ltd., Guangdong Hongbang Metal and Aluminum Co., Ltd., Guangdong Hongjin Metal Aluminum Co., Ltd., Guangdong Huajin Metal Profile Co., Ltd., Nantong Hongjin Metal Aluminum Co., Ltd. and Wuhan Hongjin Metal Aluminum Co., Ltd. The Entity specialises in the production of Aluminium alloy ingots and Aluminium alloy liquids.

Located in a Government-designated industrial zone, the Entity is not in proximity to sensitive areas such as Indigenous lands, schools, scenic spots or drinking water source areas. Its main production processes include Aluminium Scrap remelting, refining, ingot casting and direct supply of molten Aluminium. In 2024, the Entity's total production was approximately 743,300 tonnes, including 506,600 tonnes of molten Aluminium and 236,700 tonnes of Aluminium ingots.

The Entity includes recreational amenities, such as sports fields, for the leisure of its employees. Key Stakeholders of the Entity include shareholders, customers, partners, downstream supply chains, and relevant Government agencies.
